


# **Our Teaching Approach**



- Coast.
- Membership Fee is non refundable in case of withdrawal from a course.
- All fees are payable in advance. Access to classes can commence only after payment is
- confirmed.
- Alliance Française de la Sunshine Coast reserves the right to cancel courses if
- minimum enrolments are not received.
- An administration fee will be charged for students cancelling their enrolment before the
- start of Term.
  - Once classes have started, no refund will be given.
  - If a course is cancelled by Alliance Française de la Sunshine Coast, students will be offered a full credit for a future or alternative course, or a full refund.
  - Classes are subject to variation due to enrolment numbers and days may be changed at the discretion of the Alliance Française de la Sunshine Coast.
